Building mutual trust and maintaining group motivation.

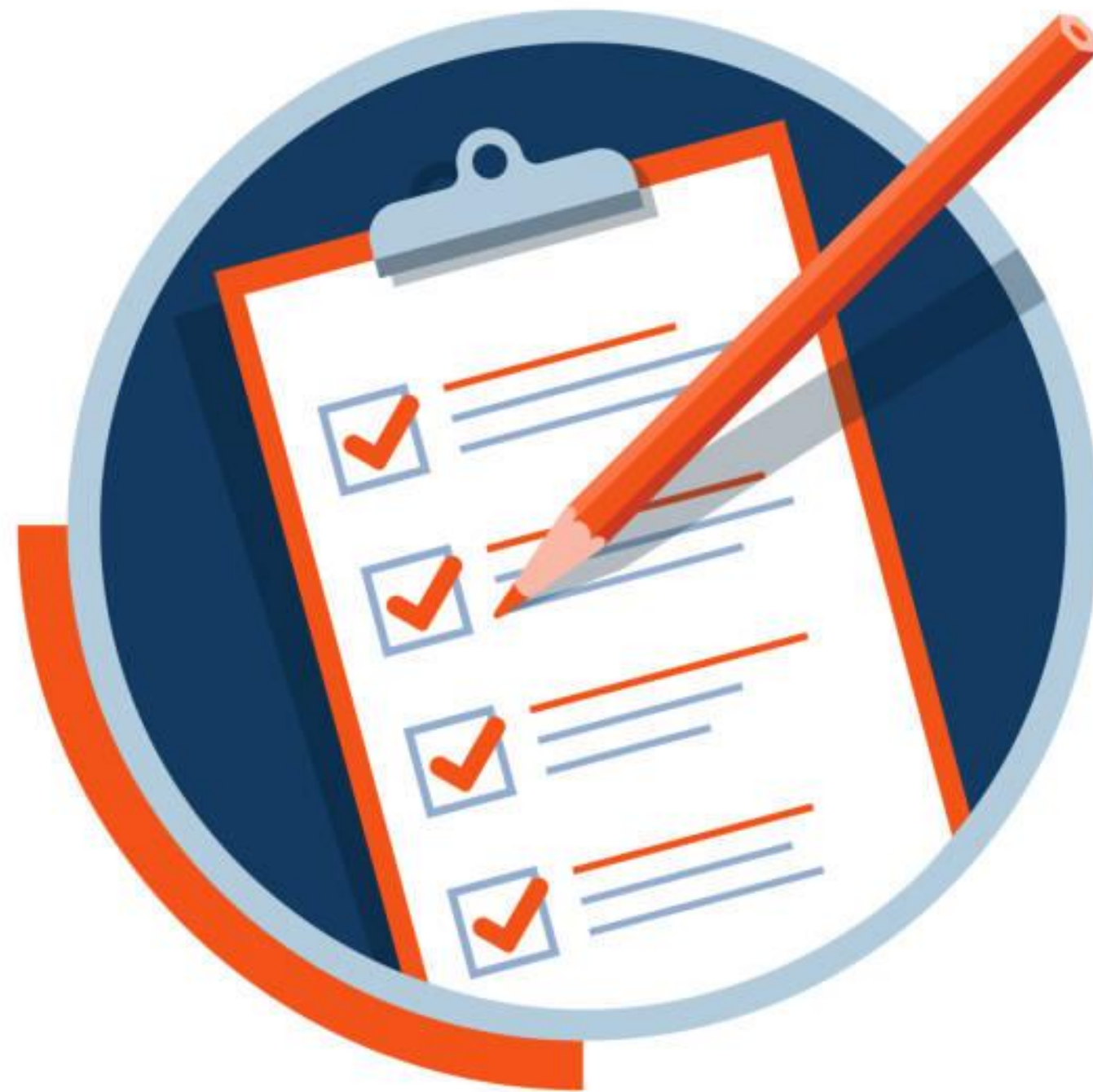
## **Effective Communication**

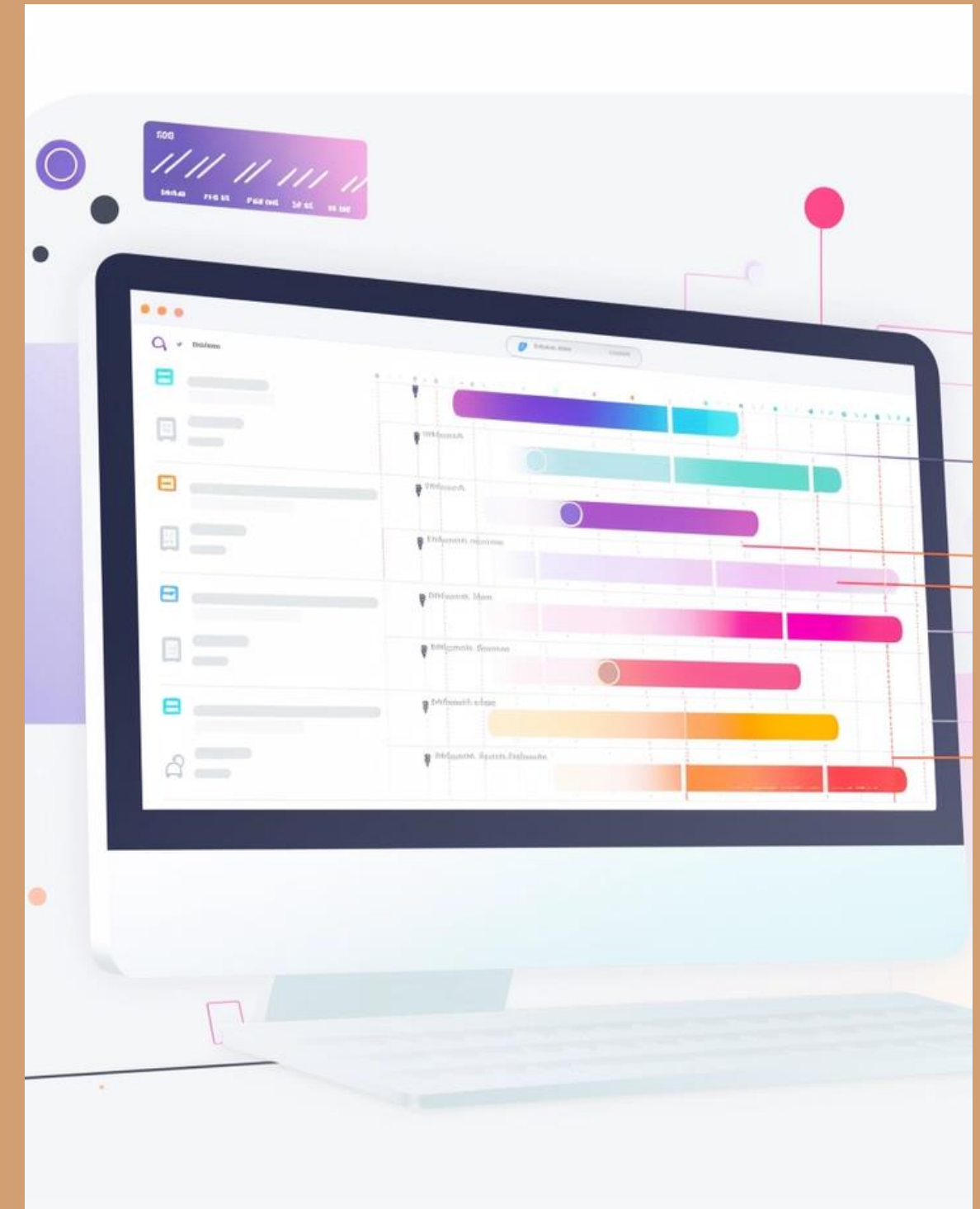

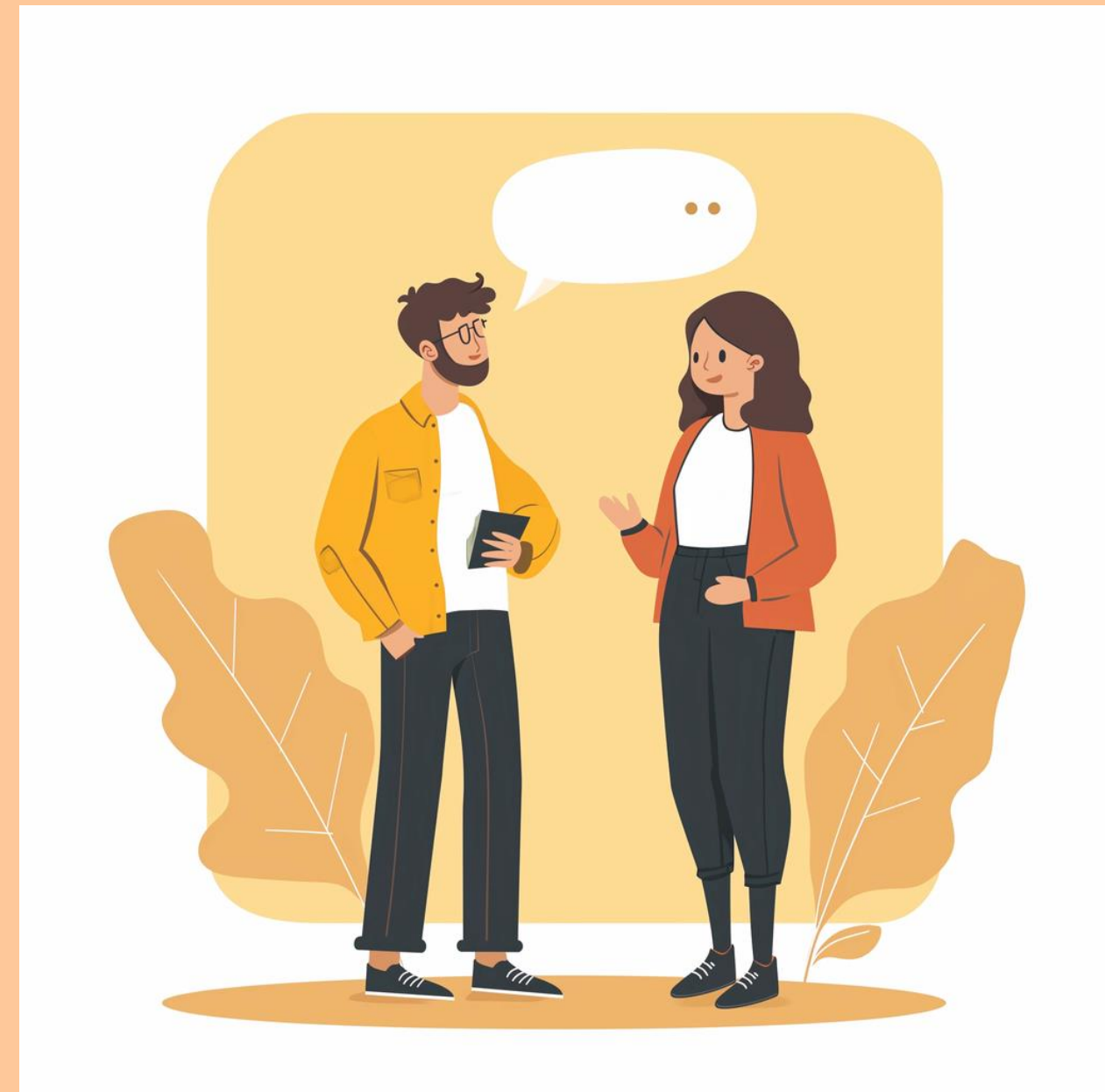

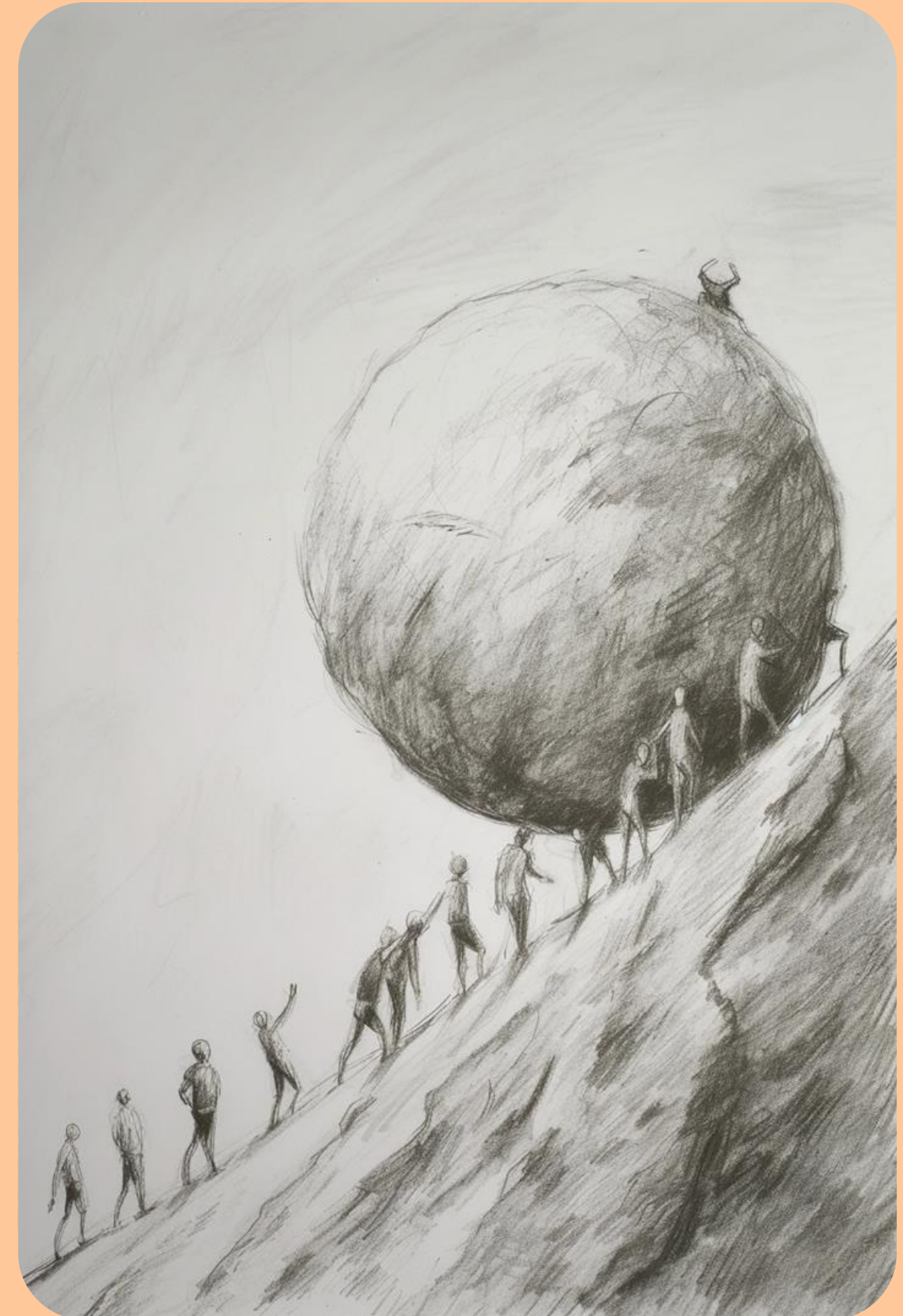

# How to Effectively Discuss Challenges

## **Identify Challenges**

Start with sharing personal experiences

## **Dive Deeper**

Discuss why these challenges occur

## **Solution Brainstorming**

Think creatively about possible solutions. Name at least two.

Lack of clear roles and responsibilities

Implement a clear communication strategy and role assignments
