



IHO Meeting Frequency


International Hydrographic Organization How many meetings does your group hold per year?





IHO Approved Work Plan


International Hydrographic Organization Does your group have an approved work plan by a higher authority for the current year?





IHO Membership Participation Rate


International Hydrographic Organization What percentage of the applicable Member States consistently participate in your group's activities?





IHO Document Production


International Hydrographic Organization How many official documents (reports, guidelines, etc.) has your group produced in the past year?





IHO Subgroup Formation


International Hydrographic Organization Has your group formed any specific task-oriented subgroups?





IHO Collaborative Initiatives


International Hydrographic Organization How many collaborative initiatives or projects involving multiple member states has your group initiated or completed in the past year?

IHO Summary

International Hydrographic Organization

- WGs are meeting 1-6 times/ year.
- Most WGs have an approved Work Plan for the year.
- Wide range of participation from MS. Some WGs have less than 25% of MS and some WGs have 100% of MS.
- Most WGs have published 2 or less official documents this year.
- Most WGs have not formed subgroups.
- Most WGs have initiated or completed less than 3 projects involving multiple MS this year.
- Most WGs regularly report to a higher authority.
